WWRY Overview

WE WILL ROCK YOU is a high-octane, adrenaline-fuelled musical featuring more than 20 iconic Queen hits, including “Bohemian Rhapsody,” “We Are the Champions,” “Somebody to Love,” “Don’t Stop Me Now,” and of course, “We Will Rock You.” Set in a post-apocalyptic future where individuality has been outlawed and music is controlled by algorithms; the story follows two young revolutionaries who dare to defy the system to save rock ‘n’ roll.

This fist-pumping, foot-stomping anthem to freedom and self-expression is a musical for our time—unapologetically bold and filled with the timeless power of Queen’s legendary music. With over 7 million fans rocked in its original 12-year West End run, **WE WILL ROCK YOU** made history as the longest-running show at London’s Dominion Theatre. Performances

There will be **five** performances of **We Will Rock You** at **St Augustine’s Catholic College, Trowbridge** from Wednesday 27 May to Saturday 30 May 2026 (including a Saturday Matinee.)

Rehearsals

Rehearsals are scheduled to begin on Tuesday, 06 January 2026.

Tuesday rehearsals will take place at *Longfield Community Centre, Weavers Drive, Trowbridge, BA14 7DZ* running from 7.30pm to 10.00pm.

Wednesday rehearsals will start from 25 February 2026 and will take place at *St John’s Church Hall, Church Lane, Trowbridge, BA14 0EH* running from 7.30pm to 10.00pm.

We will be issuing a full rehearsal schedule in due course including a Sunday Rehearsal in May but please indicate any unavailable dates on your registration form or let the Producer know as soon as possible.



Promotional Event

We will be hoping to hold a promotional day, including a photoshoot, leaflet drop, and singing event, will take place at the Weavers Market, Trowbridge, in May 2026. We are still waiting for the exact dates but please be aware that **all** cast will be required. Details to follow.

Show Week Schedule

- ☆ **Get-in:** Saturday, 23 May & Sunday, 24 May at St Augustine's. All available assistance is appreciated.
- ☆ **Band Call:** Sunday, 24 May. Full cast attendance required.
- ☆ **Technical Rehearsal:** Monday, 25 May.
- ☆ **Dress Rehearsal:** Tuesday, 26 May.
- ☆ **Get-out:** Following the final performance on Saturday, 30 May, all cast members will be assigned roles to assist with the theatre clear-down.

Please note: This is an adult production and we require all performers to be aged 16 and over.

Membership and Show Fees

To audition, an annual membership fee (01 January 2026 to 31 December 2026) is required to be paid prior to your audition. Non-payment will result in your audition being cancelled.

Membership (Over 16 Years) - £20.00

A show subscription fee is required for each production to cover essential expenses, including venue hire, costumes, licensing, and technical support. These fees are set at a reasonable level and must be paid by 30 April 2026. Should you wish to arrange payment by instalments, please contact the Membership Secretary to discuss available options.

Audition Details

To secure your audition spot, your registration and audition forms along with membership fee must be submitted by the evening of Friday, 12 December.

Wednesday, 10 December will be a dance workshop, so please bring suitable footwear and a drink!

Venue – St John's Church Hall

Tuesday, 16 December will be the main auditions for all principal and ensemble speaking parts.

Timings will be communicated soon.

Venue – Longfield Community Centre

Due to anticipated high interest, please prepare material for no more than two roles. When registering, specify your preferred and non-preferred roles.

The audition panel will include the creative team and one independent committee member.
